**PURPOSE OF REPORT:**

The table below sets out the ETTF bids that were approved as part of the CCG's offer to practices for additional ETTF funding, to support equipment/technology updates, as agreed at the last Joint Co-Commissioning Committee. These were assessed by a panel of 4, including clinical input (these were a sub-group of the members of the Primary Care Commissioning Committee).

The criteria was:

- Federations/practices to submit innovative ideas in relation to equipment that supports patients to be maintained within primary care/practice setting and avoids the need for onward referral or helps to ensure that all appropriate investigations/tests are completed prior to referral

A total of £8418 has been approved. This is affordable within the envelope identified.

Going Paperless: PC based Spirometer Machine x 4 (across 4 sites) & ECG Machine x 1 (already have 3 across 4 sites). This enables patients to have their tests done at different sites and for results to be viewed from any site.	<b>£5,614.80</b>
A 24 hour blood pressure monitor required to allow practice within NICE guidelines for hypertension and avoid referrals to secondary care for this investigation. Also a 24 hour ECG Recorder required, again reducing referrals to Cardiology and the Arrhythmia clinic at DPoW.	<b>£2,803.19</b>
