PURPOSE OF REPORT:	<p>The NHS England Planning Guidance 2017 to 2019 set out a requirement for CCGs to make non-recurrent funding available to support general practice transformation.</p> <p>In line with the development of the local GP Forward View plan, the CCG identified £3 per head of population per annum to be invested over the 2 years 2017/18 and 2018/19. This is part of the overall investment into general practice, which was approved by the Committee last year.</p> <p>The attached spreadsheet shows the CCG's planned investment into general practice from 2017 to 2021, including the required non-recurrent support, and outlines the specific areas for non-recurrent investment within 2018/19.</p> <p>The Committee is asked to ratify the 2018/19 investment, which has already been factored into 2018/19 budgets.</p>
