PURPOSE OF REPORT:

This report has been prepared to seek the approval of the Committee to the 2018/19 draft agreement for GPFV Federation Development Monies. As explained within the paper for Item 6d, the NHS England Shared Planning Guidance 2017 to 2019 set out a requirement for CCGs to make £3 per head of population non-recurrent funding available for general practice transformational support; NELCCG has provided an element of this, which equates to £1.20 per head of population per annum, specifically to support practices to develop collaborative / 'at scale' arrangements. This is aimed at helping practices with the development work required to transition to these arrangements through backfill and/or temporary support.

During 2017/18, the 3 local Federations have successfully developed their working arrangements, including development of appropriate governance structures, supported by terms of reference and MOU. Progress regarding working together has been demonstrated through their plans for extended access and the primary chronic and complex (LTC) service, as well as the Quality Scheme (more detailed provided under Item 9). All 3 Federations have submitted individual end of year reports to the primary care team setting out their progress. Most are now progressing to establishing legal entities (although the CCG is **not** funding the costs of this). The three Federations have also collectively agreed a revised terms of reference for the GP Provider Group, which is the forum within which they all come together on a monthly basis.

The 2018/19 draft agreement is attached. As well as continued development of the practices and Federation, this year's agreement also focuses on more effective engagement within the wider system, specifically the ACP. The Committee is asked to approve the 2018/19 agreement.
