### **General Fraud Awareness**

This session explores what we mean by "NHS Fraud", different types of fraud you may encounter at work, and how to report concerns.

#### **Fraud Awareness for Managers**

he journey to excellence

Designed for people who have line management responsibilities, this session looks at how managers can make sure they are aware of fraud risks and how these can be mitigated.

## **Cyber Enabled Fraud**

All NHS staff are potential targets for cyber fraudsters. This session looks at the common tactics that are used by cyber fraudsters, how to spot and avoid these tactics, and how to report concerns depending on the specific method that has been used.

#### **Creditor Payment Fraud**

This session looks at invoice fraud, mandate fraud, CEO fraud and other methodologies being used by criminals to try and divert NHS payments.

#### **Recruitment Fraud**

Perfect for staff who undertake pre-employment checks, this session looks at how to spot counterfeit and forged identity documents. It also covers qualification fraud, failure to disclose criminal convictions, and dishonest job applications.

## **Payroll Fraud**

This session explores several different topics including timesheet fraud, working whilst sick, cyber enabled salary diversion, and ESR fraud.

# Social Engineering and the Psychology of Fraud

A one-off session looking at how social engineering is used by criminals to facilitate fraud offences, how psychology can provide fraudsters with leverage and what leads someone to commit fraud in the first place.
